

It is a verbal sin against God. It has to do with "acknowledgement" in a more general sense.


#### What is "blasphemy"

"It is desecration of the holy character of God. It can involve insulting Him, mocking Him, or dishonoring Him. In a sense, it is the opposite of praise."



#### Suggestion #2

Believers in Christ are not capable of committing an unforgivable sin because of the sealing work of the Holy Spirit.

Having believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit, 14 who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance until the redemption of those who are God's possession—to the praise of his glory. Eph 1:13–14.

#### Suggestion #3

This account in Mark helps us to understand the theological importance that Christ is placing on being a part of the spiritual family of God. It is not physical descent that makes one right with God.
